INTENT

The teaching of RE at Charlton enables all children to learn **about** and **from** religion and non-religious world views. Our curriculum provides opportunities to reflect, respond and appreciate the way that religion and non-religious world views shapes life and behaviours. It will aid children’s ability to make reasoned and informed judgements, address common misconceptions and enhance their personal, moral, social, cultural and spiritual development.

The children will learn RE through a clear, coherent and progressive curriculum, following the Oxfordshire Agreed Syllabus and using the Oxford Diocesan Board of Education RE planning units based around the “Big Question.”
