VISION

Our vision is that every pupil leaves Charlton with a broad passion for, and understanding of, their world and their place within it. Pupils will have the knowledge and skills to explore our ever-changing planet and do their part to protect its future.

INTENT

At Charlton, we believe that all children should be given opportunities to connect with their environment, both locally and across the wider world. Our curriculum is designed to encourage our pupils to 'work like a geographer' and challenge their thinking; asking questions about the world in which they live.
